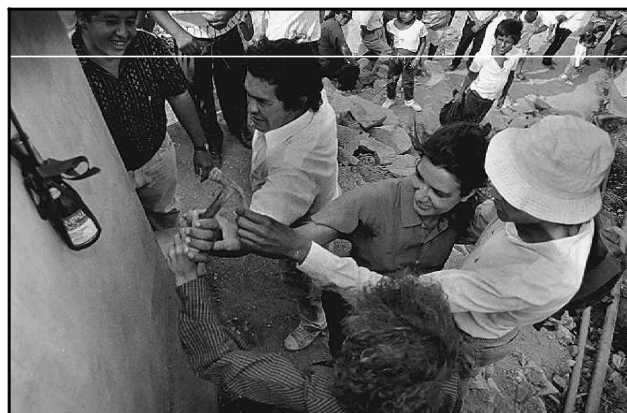

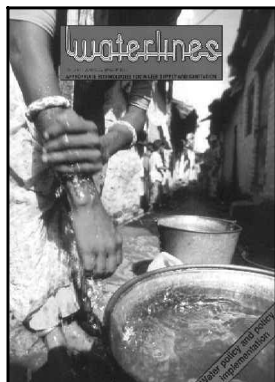
'Classic' works
